













VANESSA GARZA LOWE MEMORIAL FUND

In 2021, we lost our dear friend and Austin Allies co-founder, Vanessa Lowe. Before Vanessa passed, a friend set up a GoFundMe in her honor to benefit Austin Allies. Those donations have sustained our organization and allowed us to grow and serve our community in bigger and better ways.

We are using a portion of these donations to form a giving program in Vanessa's name and we are excited that it's off to a great start! In December, in partnership with local bookseller BookPeople, Austin Allies provided 250 new books to 10 Austin ISD and 2 Pflugerville ISD Battle of the Books high school programs.







We have also just launched an annual program to grant two Austin ISD middle school libraries with \$2500 each to expand their collections.

Vanessa loved reading, visiting bookstores and libraries, meeting authors, and sharing her love of literature with children of all ages, so we are very proud and honored to run this giving campaign in her memory.




